Partners with Universities for imparting on job-training



Noble Care Foundation partners with Universities to impart on job-training in their relevant areas of education. Every year 25 students from ISPAJ university from various discipline take part in this training, that goes for two months or more, depending on the module and the curriculum.

Physical career-focused training is getting closer to being embedded within college curricula rather than existing as its own separate credential and certificate program. NCF has championed this cause and has helped students immensely.

The move to include private career training programs in public and private universities/college helps the Group in building a talent pool base, for inducting and giving them an option for their career.

Being able to provide a credible training program that fits neatly into extension programs and continuing education helps expand the variety of offerings for students, especially non-traditional students who may want to chose a particular career, rather than looking for a career from a different stream or discipline.

It helps the university to tailor their programs, and make the students better prepared for the job market and options for specializing further too. This makes a win-win for the Group and the University!
